PURPOSE: THIS SCHOLARSHIP REPRESENTS THE ATLANTA ALUMNI CHAPTER'S PLEDGE AND COMMITMENT TO ASSIST THE UNIVERSITY IN ATTRACTING AND RECRUITING QUALITY STUDENTS FOUND IN THE METRO ATLANTA AREA AND SURROUNDING AREAS OF GEORGIA. THE ALUMNI ARE CONVINCED THAT HIGH ACADEMIC ACHIEVERS FROM GEORGIA ARE NEEDED ON THE CAMPUS TO SERVE AS ROLE MODELS FOR ALL STUDENTS MATRICULATING AT THE UNIVERSITY.

LEVEL OF AWARD: DEPENDING UPON THE APPLICATIONS RECEIVED, A MINIMUM OF TWO AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE DESERVING STUDENTS WHO MEET THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA. THIS AWARD IS A PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP, WHICH CAN BE USED TOWARDS TUITION OR BOOKS.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: TO BE ELIGIBLE, A CANDIDATE MUST:

- (A) BE A HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT FROM THE METRO ATLANTA AREA OR SURROUNDING AREAS OF GEORGIA.
- (B) HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION TO NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY AND BE COMMITTED TO ATTENDING, ENTERING AS A FRESHMAN IN THE FALL 2014 OR SPRING 2015 SEMESTER. YOU MUST INCLUDE A COPY OF YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER FROM THE UNIVERSITY IN YOUR APPLICATION PACKET.
- (C) HAVE ACCUMULATED A GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) OF 3.0 OR BETTER ON A 4.0 SCALE.
- (D) INCLUDE TWO RECOMMENDATIONS/EVALUATION LETTERS; ONE BEING FROM A NON-SCHOOL OFFICIAL. MUST BE ENCLOSED IN SEALED ENVELOPES. (***PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE LETTERS FROM RELATIVES.*)
- (E) INCLUDE AN OFFICIAL COPY OF YOUR HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT. THE TRANSCRIPT MUST BE ENCLOSED IN A SEALED ENVELOPE.
