- (A) BE A HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT FROM THE METRO ATLANTA AREA OR SURROUNDING AREAS OF GEORGIA.
- (B) HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION TO NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY AND BE COMMITTED TO ATTENDING, ENTERING AS A FRESHMAN IN THE FALL 2014 OR SPRING 2015 SEMESTER. YOU MUST INCLUDE A COPY OF YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER FROM THE UNIVERSITY IN YOUR APPLICATION PACKET.
- (C) HAVE ACCUMULATED A GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) OF 3.0 OR BETTER ON A 4.0 SCALE.
- (D) INCLUDE TWO RECOMMENDATIONS/EVALUATION LETTERS; ONE BEING FROM A NON-SCHOOL OFFICIAL. MUST BE ENCLOSED IN SEALED ENVELOPES. (**PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE LETTERS FROM RELATIVES.)
- (E) INCLUDE AN OFFICIAL COPY OF YOUR HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT. THE TRANSCRIPT MUST BE ENCLOSED IN A SEALED ENVELOPE.
